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Sustainable Tourism Development and its Impact on Local Economic Growth

Pembangunan Pariwisata Berkelanjutan dan Dampaknya terhadap Pertumbuhan Ekonomi Lokal

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ABSTRACT

Sustainable tourism development has become the main focus in efforts to maintain a balance between local economic growth and environmental preservation. In this context, the integration of local wisdom plays an important role in directing tourism practices towards sustainability. In this research, we conducted a systematic review of related literature to explore the contribution of integrating local wisdom in sustainable tourism management to local economic growth. The research method used is a systematic literature review by collecting articles from international databases such as Scopus, Web of Science, and Google Scholar. ABSTRAK

Pengembangan pariwisata berkelanjutan telah menjadi fokus utama dalam upaya menjaga keseimbangan antara pertumbuhan ekonomi lokal dan pelestarian lingkungan. Dalam konteks ini, integrasi kearifan lokal memainkan peran penting dalam mengarahkan praktek-praktek pariwisata menuju keberlanjutan. Dalam penelitian ini, kami melakukan tinjauan sistematis terhadap literatur terkait untuk mengeksplorasi kontribusi integrasi kearifan lokal dalam pengelolaan pariwisata berkelanjutan terhadap pertumbuhan ekonomi lokal. Tourism villages embody local wisdom, promoting environmental sustainability (Lemy et al., 2022).

In conclusion, integrating local wisdom into sustainable tourism management is essential for fostering local economic growth while preserving heritage and the environment. Collaborative efforts involving communities, stakeholders, and governance structures are crucial for achieving sustainable tourism development goals.

The PRISMA (Preferred Reporting Items for Systematic Reviews and Meta-Analyses) method was used as a guide to carry out the article screening process. The PRISMA guide provides a structured workflow for carrying out literature systematization, including the search, selection and results presentation stages. The use of the PRISMA method helps ensure transparency, accountability, and overall quality of this literature review. Thus, the research methods used in this study ensure that the article collection and selection process is carried out carefully and structured in accordance with internationally recognized research standards.

3. Results and Discussions

Arabic language learning has been emphasized as a means to ensure its continuity and relevance in the modern era (Mardana et al., 2022; Sarip et al., 2022). Studies have also shown that integrating local wisdom into educational materials and textbooks can be an effective strategy to develop students' religious characters and enhance their learning experiences (Darmayenti et al., 2021).

In conclusion, while challenges exist in integrating local wisdom into educational practices, the benefits are significant in terms of character development, critical thinking, and cultural preservation. By addressing these challenges and leveraging the opportunities presented by local wisdom, educators can create enriching learning environments that promote holistic student development.

Insufficient data and information about local wisdom and its economic potential can also be a barrier in developing effective strategies and policies for sustainable tourism management (Handayani & Lazuardi, 2022).

By recognizing and understanding these challenges, stakeholders can take appropriate measures to overcome these obstacles and enhance the integration of local wisdom in sustainable tourism management. This deep understanding is crucial for designing effective and sustainable strategies that leverage local wisdom in tourism development (Sudirtha et al., 2019).

4. Conclusion

From the results of the discussion that has been presented, it can be concluded that sustainable tourism development plays an important role in efforts to maintain a balance between economic growth, environmental preservation and respect for cultural heritage. The concept of sustainable tourism development has evolved from a primary focus on environmental sustainability to also paying attention to social and economic aspects. The integration of local wisdom in the development of sustainable tourism is an important key in achieving this goal.
